They offer one policy that is similar to that and one that costs more initially but we would not have a deductible and we would not have to repay losses. we are currently structured. The proposal from the council was that the Recorder talk to URMMA and determine what it will cost the City to get out of the contract with them and whether or not we need to buy a Tail Policy to cover any losses that may not have been reported.
