The Mt. Pleasant City Council held a regular meeting May 26, 2015 at 1:00 p.m. The meeting was held in Council Chambers, 115 West Main Street, Mt. Pleasant, Utah

**1. Welcome:**

**2. Roll call:**

Monte Bona explained that by rewriting the resolution the way he did was to show the voters that we are trying to do our best with the money for the roads. If they want it to be different then they will need to vote for the local option.

Mayor Blackham explained that the time to declare candidacy will be next week. June 1 through June 8. It will effect Monte Bona, Ann Deuel and Jeff McDonald. We have some folks that have talked about running but nothing can happen until June 1.

Kevin Stallings asked about having the restrooms open over by the Rodeo grounds by Memorial Day. He asked if we would do a work order to turn the water on and open those restrooms.

Monte Bona asked Kevin Stallings if he had talked Alan Sherman about when he was going to start on the curb and gutter project. Kevin said that he will talk to him today.
