MT. PLEASANT CITY RESOLUTION 2016-13

A RESOLUTION BY THE MT. PLEASANT CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING A PROPOSITION TO BE PLACED ON THE BALLOT OF THE GENERAL ELECTION, NOVEMBER 8, 2016.

WHEREAS, Mt. Pleasant City in accordance with Section 11-26-1 of the Utah State Code and Mt. Pleasant City Ordinance 97-05-27A desires to submit to the voters a proposition pertaining to a local charge.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council does hereby resolve as follows:

At the General Election called for November 8, 2016, the following proposition shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the City of Mt. Pleasant:

“Should Mt. Pleasant City be authorized to add 2 1/4 % to the local charge set forth in Section 11-26-1 of the Utah State Code and Mt. Pleasant City Ordinance 97-05-27A for

the express purpose of operating and maintaining a year-round swimming pool/aquatic center”?
